The said Jephtha Hawley when he left the Colonies in the year 1776 was possessed of a good large grained house and Barn and his land horses and one or two old mares yoke of Oxen and several Cows and young Cattle and a number of Sheep and Hogs and a good Farm with about fifty or sixty ~~acres~~ <sup>acres</sup> ~~or~~ <sup>under</sup> good improvement and a quantity of arable land and a plenty of grain in the house and Barn and a considerable of grain stored on the farm and a good set of farming tools and the house well furnished with household furniture

The said Hawley was counted an honest and true man

Ichabod Hawley

deposed to on the 12th day of February 1785
